
KENYA VETERINARY BOARD STOPS RECOGNIZING KALT

During its meeting held on 4th February 2016, the Kenya Veterinary Board noted with concern the failure of Kenya Association of Livestock Technicians (KALT) to provide information on the matters which have been going on in the Association from 2014 as had been requested.

Consequently, the meeting resolved that:-

- (i) KALT will no longer be recognized by the Board as an Association representing interests of veterinary paraprofessionals due to integrity matters, poor conduct of some of its officials/members and non-compliance with the provisions of the Code of Ethics guiding conduct of those in the profession. This decision takes effect from 8th February, 2016.
- (ii) The Board will therefore not rely on any documentation from the association while considering new applicants for registration. However, those already registered will not be affected by this decision.

You are requested to take note of the decision and pass over the information accordingly to those concerned.
