ANNOUNCEMENT

MINIMUM CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATE AND DIPLOMA IN ANIMAL HEALTH AND PRODUCTION, EFFECTIVE FROM 1ST JANUARY, 2020

Kenya Veterinary Board has revised the requirements for admission into the Certificate and Diploma in Animal Health and Production Course offered in approved training institutions. Consequently, below are the approved entry requirements by the Board:

CERTIFICATE

EITHER

- i) The trainees should have completed Kenya Certificate of Secondary School Education (KSCE) with an average mean grade of C minus (C-) and minimum of a C- in Biology or Biological Sciences or equivalent as determined by the KVB

OR

- ii) A minimum of one year certificate with a credit pass in Range Management/Wildlife Health/Dairy Management/Animal Science/Animal Husbandry/Animal Production/Leather Technology/Agriculture or equivalent as determined by the KVB from Institutions recognized by Kenya National Qualifications Authority (KNQA).

DIPLOMA

EITHER

- i) Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education (KCSE) with an aggregate of C and a grade of at least C in Biology or Biological Sciences and C- in Chemistry or Physical Science and C- in either Mathematics or Physics or Agriculture

OR

- ii) KCE/EACE with a Division II and at least a credit in Biology or Biological Sciences, Chemistry or Physical Sciences and a credit in either Mathematics, Physics or Agriculture

OR

- iii) Certificate in Animal Health and Production or Certificate in Animal Health and Range Management from Institutions recognized by KVB

OR

- iv) Credit pass in at least a two year certificate course in Agriculture/Animal Production/Animal Husbandry/Range Management/Wildlife Health/Dairy Technology or equivalent from institutions recognized by Kenya National Qualifications Authority (KNQA)

OR

- v) KACE level certificate with a principal pass in Biology and at least a subsidiary pass in Chemistry, Physics or Mathematics

OR

vi) Diploma in Biomedical discipline recognized by the KNQA

OR

vii) Any other qualification equivalent to the above from an institution recognized by the KVB

Please take note of the adjustments and act accordingly.

NOTE: BVM and BSc course entry requirements remain as before
